Disciples AND Apostles

After his suffering he presented himself alive to them by many convincing proofs, appearing to them during forty days and speaking about the kingdom of God. While staying with them, he ordered them not to leave Jerusalem, but to wait there for the promise of the Father. "This," he said, "is what you have heard from me; for John baptized with water, but you will be baptized with the Holy Spirit not many days from now." Acts 1:3-5

In the days after Easter we encounter the risen Christ. He returns from the grave, triumphantly, and then he spends 40 days with his disciples (those who follower) teaching them how to be apostles (those sent out). At the end of the season, on Ascension Day (May 18th this year) he ascends into heaven. The Disciples return to Jerusalem and wait to become the Apostles. On Pentecost (May 28th this year) they are baptized with the Holy Spirit and are empowered to go out and spread the Good news of Jesus' life, death, and resurrection.

This month we are invited to remember that, we too, are disciples, followers of Jesus. We are called, like Peter, James, John, and all the rest to follow Jesus. We are invited to learn from Jesus about how the Kingdom of God has come near. We are commanded, like those who gathered with Jesus at the Last Supper, to love one another like Jesus loved.

Yet, we are also apostles, those who have been baptized by the Holy Spirit and sent out to share the Gospel. Like the women at the tomb, we are sent to "go quickly" and tell everyone that, "Jesus has been raised from the dead!" We know the story of Jesus' life, death, and resurrection. We know many who need to hear this good news! Many who struggle to see joy or hope or love in their daily life. We are the ones sent out to be God's messengers about God's love for all the world. Having encountered the risen Christ, having been baptized by the Holy Spirit, we must be apostles, sent to offer a word of hope and resurrection for a world in need of Good News!

-Pastor Erik led with a devotion.

Past Minutes

- -March 8th Council minutes were read.
- -Ceph moved to approve the minutes. Becky seconded. motion carried.

Treasure's Report

- -March's Reports were reviewed and discussed.
- Taylor moved to approve the Treasurer's Report. Ceph seconded. Motion carried.

Old Business

- -Parsonage still waiting for garage door to be repaired and work on list of minor fixes.
- Garage was rearranged so should be able to get to the garage door now.
- -Youth director there were 2 candidates selected, looking at start date of the summer. Titles are *Children*, *youth and family director* and *Children*, *youth and family assistant*. Reviewed time that would be allotted for English Lutheran. Taylor motioned to continue with 2 positions with Christians in action. Seconded by Ceph. Motion carried.
- -Seminary placement intern has been assigned but wouldn't starting until January 2024.
- -Discussion about new member class, want to look at what has been done in the past, look at directory and contacts. Add community members to online system "Realm." This will be a great place to have contacts of church members.
- -Add Kennedy to payroll. Becky motioned to have this set up. Ceph seconded. Motion carried.
- Discussion if people substitute as pianist. Wouldn't add to payroll but would be given honorarium. Ceph motioned to pay substitute \$50 each Sunday they would play. Becky seconded. Motion carried.
- -Care package, will announce during next service and get some signage on the basket. Will run 2 more Sundays. Plan to deliver after that.
- -Ethel has started entering some of the congregation information into Realm.

New Business

- -Was able to get the overflow video and sound to work via a laptop, with an HDMI cord to TV. Could we get an inexpensive laptop to use just for this purpose.
- -Discussed if we would at some point remove the extra pews from the sanctuary with the ability to use the TV in fellowship hall for potential overflow, will have more discussions with church members on history of pews.
- -Discussed if we should have a yearly joint council meeting with St. Johns Lutheran out of Jamestown.

- » Six business committees support the work of the voting members as they consider proposed constitutional changes, memorials from synodical women's organizations, a proposed budget and more.
- » Voting members of the Twelfth Triennial Convention will elect officers and women to serve on the church-wide executive board for the remainder of 2023-2026 triennium.
- » Among the benefits of participating in Women of the ELCA is the opportunity to have a voice in determining the activities and direction of the organization. Where we go and what we do as a church-wide organization will be shaped, in part, by the voting members of the Twelfth Triennial Convention.
